


FORCE BE WITH YOU MAY IT

Mistakes To Avoid When Trying For The Perfect Lawn

aving a healthy green lawn can be a source of pride to any homeowner. It can also be a frustrating process if you are having trouble keeping your grass green and lush.

There are a few common mistakes that homeowners make when caring for their lawns. Avoid these pitfalls to help make the job easier.

Cutting Grass Too Short

If you want your lawn to look as good as a golf course, resist the temptation to cut it too short. Golf courses use a special type of grass that responds well to a short cutting height. But most lawns require more water and put

more stress on the grass when cut too short. Your best bet is to cut only to about three inches and no shorter. With this length, the grass holds moisture and can resist disease better.



Too Much Fertilizer

Putting down too much fertilizer does not make for a healthier lawn. Grass can only absorb so much fertilizer before it starts to become stressed. Excess fertilizer is washed from your lawn and can flow down your street into waterways, becoming a pollutant. Most agricultural experts recommend applying fertilizer in June, August, and October. Excessive fertilizing in the early spring can cause grass to grow too quickly, resulting in a plant with a weak root structure that is hard to maintain.

Too Much Water

Most people are concerned about not watering their lawns enough, but more damage comes from over-

watering than under-watering. Too much water results in shallow roots and a weak plant. In general, most grass needs about one inch of watering a week.

By The Numbers: Greeting Cards

- U.S. consumers purchase approximately seven billion greeting cards each year.
- Women purchase more than 80 percent of all greeting cards, but men generally spend more on a single card than women.
- The most popular everyday cards sent are birthday (60%), anniversary, (8%), get well (7%), friendship (6%), and sympathy (6%).
- The most popular seasonal cards are Christmas (60%), Valentine's Day (25%), Mother's Day (4%), Easter (3%), and Father's Day (3%).
- The average person receives more than 20 cards per year, about one-third of which are birthday cards.



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Warmer weather brings out the birds and the bees--and all sorts of other bugs. Summertime pests are not only a nuisance; they can also carry and transmit harmful diseases. How can you get these bugs to buzz off? Here are some tips.

- Before doing any chores outside, check for wasp nests. If you see any activity, you will need to spray the nest to kill the wasps.
- If you are eating and drinking outdoors, be safe before taking a bite or a gulp. Pour sodas into clear plastic cups instead of drinking from a can.
- If you are stung by a wasp or a bee, carefully remove the stinger if you can see it. Then squeeze out any venom,



wash with soap and water, and treat with an antibiotic ointment. Treat with ice if there is any swelling.

- Use a repellent with DEET to protect against mosquito bites. Do not use products containing DEET on children under the age of two months. Only use sparingly on kids.
- If you are entering an area with lots of mosquitoes, wear a longsleeved shirt and long pants. Tuck the bottom of your pant legs into

your socks.

- Remove any standing water around your home. Mosquitoes can breed in a very shallow amount of water. Be sure to empty buckets, birdbaths, and other places where water can puddle.



Staying in a poor accommodation can turn any good vacation into a nightmare. Many people think they have to spend a lot of money to get great accommodation but that really isn't the case.
